Teams to be seeded and registered nordic breed teams shall be marked on the entry form. For contestants in junior classes a signed ESDRA Junior Waiver Form has to be submitted also.

PARTICIPATION FEE:

CHF 80,- for all nome style sprint classes, CHF 60,- for all pulka or skijoring style classes, CHF 100,- for a pulka or skijoring relay team, CHF 100,- for all mid-distance classes.

The participation fee shall be received, February 25^{th} 2003 at the latest, at the ESDRA bank account at Zürcher Kantonalbank, CH-8712 Stäfa / Switzerland, account no. 1104-1283.035 (free of charge for the receiver).

According to a ESDRA Congress decision late nominations and / or payments (received after said date) will double the participation fee!

RACE OFFICIALS:

RACE REGULATIONS: ESDRA race rules & ESDRA regulations part IV chap. II

mandatory equipment in sprint classes:

- a second snow hook for the unlimited class and the 8 dog class;
- an adequate braking pad (drag) as per race rule 2.2.6 for all nome style classes.

mandatory equipment in mid-distance classes:

- a second snow hook for the unlimited class;
- an adequate braking pad (drag) as per race rule 2.2.6;
- a first aid kit for humans and animal-related emergencies;
- two sets of dog booties for each dog on the team (either carried on the sled or in use).

The 150% time disqualification rule shall apply.

Doping tests for drivers and dogs may be performed.

All dogs participating shall be marked with a microchip before their arrival at the race site and shall be listed on the chipping form.

It is strictly forbidden to let dogs run loose at the stake out- & parking area during the event.

All participating nations shall appoint one team leader for all nome style classes (sprint & middistance) and one team leader for the pulka and skijoring classes (part II, chap. B § 3.7). The team leaders shall be noted on the entry forms. Team leaders shall be present at the team leader meetings, in view of their liaison task between the race organizer and their team members.

ANIMAL WELFARE:

Participants shall fulfil the applicable requirements as per the ESDRA Sled Dog Care Guidelines and the recommendations issued by the Animal Welfare Committee.
